Checklist

PLAN & PREPARE

Have you:

- 1) Received the proof of visa grant?
 - 2) Checked your orientation and course start date?
 - 3) Booked your flight?
 - 4) Organized accommodation in Australia?
 - 5) Organized airport pickup in Australia?
 - 6) Familiarized yourself with the overall cost of living in Australia and set realistic budget for some time?
 - 7) Planned to take cash/travellers' cheque (preferably in Australian Dollars) with you?
 - 8) Made a list of people including your friends and relatives who you will be meeting prior to departure for Australia?
 - 9) Made a shopping list?
 - 10) Made a list of to-do-activities prior to your departure to Australia?
 - 11) Made an appointment with doctors, dentists or optometrists for any of your health issues?
 - 12) Collected AUD cash or traveller's cheque?
 - 13) Gone through customs and quarantine regulations of Australia to understand what ITEMS are NOT allowed and what must be DECLARED on the passenger incoming card?
 - 14) Made ready all your clothing needs, stationeries, electronics, cooking and bedding needs and other relevant items?
 - 15) Checked your maximum baggage weight limit with the travel agency?
 - 16) Have you made certified copies of all the documents you are taking with you?
- These documents include passport, visa grant notice, offer letter, CoEs, citizenship certificate, birth registration certificate, academic certificates and other documents.*



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PRIORITY PACKING

- 1) All the necessary documents
- A valid passport
- Visa grant notice
- Air ticket
- Signed offer letter
- Letter of Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE)
- Letter of scholarship award (if any)
- Proof of payment
- All academic documents (originals)
- If planning to apply for course credit/subject exemption for your previous study, the following documents
- Course details of the previous study
- Subject duration
- Total study hours & placement hours (if any)
- Assessment used
- Textbook used

Remember to keep a pen (black or blue) with you at all times during your travel.

- Certified & translated copies of birth certificate, citizenship certificate, driver's licence, and marriage certificate (if any)
 - Medical records, especially immunization history of all who are going, and medicine and its prescriptions by a doctor
 - And, other documents that may be relevant
 - (Note: Please keep all these documents in your carry-on baggage. You will be allowed a laptop bag as well in addition to your carry-on baggage.)*
- 2) Adaptor plugs for electronics especially laptops and mobile charges, screen protectors for your mobiles, earphones, and extra data cable in your carry-on baggage (*hand-carry*)
 - 3) Cash/travellers' cheque (preferably in Australian dollar and around AUD 2000)
 - 4) Recorded details of address and contact numbers in Australia where you will be staying



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- 5) All your clothing needs, stationeries, electronics, cooking and bedding needs and other relevant items

Finally:

- **Carefully check all items or even gifts that you are asked to carry for friends or relatives, to make sure you are not carrying anything illegal. Failing to do this may get you into unexpected trouble and/or you may have to pay a heavy fine – or even go to prison!**
- Weigh your luggage and carry-on baggage to keep them within the permitted weight limits
- Re-confirm your flight time and be in the airport at least three hours prior to your flight.
